Dr. Daniel P. Chin joined the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation in 2007 and currently serves as the Senior Program Officer responsible for tuberculosis (TB) projects with China. In this capacity, he works with the Chinese Ministry of Health and many other national and international partners to develop projects from development of new TB drugs, vaccines and other tools to demonstration of a comprehensive program to tackle the TB problem in China. Prior to joining the foundation, Dr. Chin was with the World Health Organization and served as the WHO Country Adviser on TB to the Chinese Ministry of Health from 1999 to 2007. He was the main international TB expert providing policy and technical support to the Ministry, the China CDC, and other international partners (e.g. World Bank, Global Fund to Fight AIDS, TB, and Malaria, DFID, JICA) working in China. He helped to formulate the essential policies and financing for the current national TB control program in China and has extensive experience implementing public health programs in China. Prior to working in China, Dr. Chin was on the medical school faculty at the University of California, San Francisco. In addition, he also worked in public health at state and city levels in the United States.
