He is currently the Associate Director for Microbial Genome Analysis at the Broad Institute, and an Associate Professor in Biomedical Engineering and Microbiology at Boston University and the Associate Director for Systems Biology at the National Emerging Infectious Diseases Laboratory. Research in the Galagan lab is focused on microbial systems biology using a combination of genomic, computational, and experimental techniques.
