Prof. Peter Lawætz Andersen is Vice President of Vaccine Research and Development at Statens Serum Institut (SSI). Prior to this he has been director of Infectious Disease Immunology (1997-2002) and the Tuberculosis Research Unit (1991-1997) both at SSI. Prof. Andersen has since 2006 been Honorary Professor at Copenhagen University. In his current position at the SSI, he is responsible for the overall coordination of vaccine research and development, covering activities from early research and to clinical development.

Prof. Andersen is the inventor of more than 20 patent families and is co author of more than 220 publications, within the field of infection, immunity and vaccine research in peer-reviewed journals.
