South African Tuberculosis Vaccine Initiative (SATVI)

Dr. Willem Hanekom is Associate Professor at the University of Cape Town and Co-Director of the South African Tuberculosis Vaccine Initiative. His clinical training was in paediatrics and paediatric infectious diseases, in South Africa and the USA. He subsequently trained in immunology at Rockefeller University in New York. His laboratory focuses on clinical studies in TB vaccinology. The largest effort aims to delineate immune correlates of vaccination-induced protection against TB. Other studies aim to characterise immunity induced by BCG and by novel boost vaccines in phase I/IIa trials, and on the best strategies to deliver these vaccines to infants.
